Dear Ann- Louise

Thank you for your correspondence; I am not satisfied that the alleged decision attached to your communique is a decision of the tribunal in which regard I respectfully;

1. Request personally signed copies of all alleged decisions of the Tribunal made in respect to matters related to me between December 2007 and today's date.
2. Observe that there is no evidence that the Tribunal has been lawfully convened.

I note that you confirm as set out below in yellow highlight.

It is my contention that as with alleged decisions of all other courts and tribunals in this country related to me that those alleged decisions are published on the instructions of the State and Commonwealth Attorneys General for an ulterior purpose and are an abuse of process being Criminal Defamation in which regard I attach some relevant applicable law.

I ask you to consider this communique as a Notice of imputed Concerns under the Uniform Code of Criminal Defamation.

It is clear to me and many others that the Attorney General has abdicated his role as Champion of the Public Interest.

As you are aware I have commenced a number of proceedings against the AAT seeking review of the exercise of Public Powers conferred under an enactment; this has caused the Tribunal to ask itself a question of law as to whether the Tribunal has Jurisdiction to hear the Proceedings (whether listed or not).

The Tribunal has failed to properly convene in order to consider this question of law AND/OR refer the question of law to the Federal Court of Australia on the instructions of the Commonwealth Attorney General amongst others as an abuse of process.

The Improper collateral purpose of the failure to convene is that of criminal defamation in order to bring my name into disrepute so that payments of the amounts admitted to be owed by the Crown to me are avoided deferred and frustrated in the application of "**the Bethcar Strategy**"

I refer to the attached list of exhibits and confirm that the amount admitted to be owed by YOU to ME is as set out in the exhibits and in particular that amount set out in the Notice to Admit Facts dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2020 and Addendum/Correction also dated 25<sup>th</sup> April 2020 that is shown as **Exhibits AMG 17a & AMG 96** (copy attached).

This is a Pecuniary Interest in the Proceedings and is a hopeless conflict of Interest.
